Canadian Electrical Code (CEC) Review Course

New course available through NSCC Online Learning: ELEA-1837 – Canadian Electrical Code (CEC) Review

Course Information

ELEA 1837 - Canadian Electrical Code (CEC) Review is now available through NSCC Online Learning as a self-study course. The course is not a mandatory component of the apprenticeship program for Construction Electrician or Industrial Electrician.

However, the course may assist many construction and industrial electrician apprentices and trade qualifiers who struggle with the use of the Canadian Electrical Code, part 1 (CEC). International trade qualifiers can also be unfamiliar with Code requirements. This course was designed to introduce these individuals to the CEC, in preparation for the certification examination.

Note: This course is **not intended** for Red Seal certified individuals nor to update certified individuals on changes to the CEC.

The course includes:

- How to use, interpret and navigate the various sections of the Canadian Electrical Code, Part 1;
- How to effectively interpret the rules; and
- Exercises to illustrate and practice interpreting and navigating techniques.

Enrolment is continuous. The course is 30 hours. There is a course-ending exam of 50 multiple-choice questions with a pass mark of 70%. Students will have up to 5 attempts at the course-ending exam before having access to NSCC faculty for support.

The course is available at regular online training rate (\$82.80) to eligible clients, subject to revision.

Eligible Clients

Approved clients of the Division who are eligible and preparing to write the Construction Electrician or Industrial Electrician Red Seal certification exam can register for this course, including:

- Fourth year or completed apprentices who are preparing to write either Red Seal certification examination;
- Trade qualifiers; or
- Other individuals granted approval by the Apprenticeship Training Division to write either Red Seal examination.
