

# Apprenticeship Training

## FAST FACTS - Fiscal Year 2010 -2011

- Since 1937, approximately 57 500 Certificates of Qualification issued
- 65 designated trades
- 5363 active apprentices
- Over 2811 employers participate in the Apprenticeship Program
- 57 employers have 10 or more registered apprentices
- 17 Joint Registration Agreements in effect
  
- 867 Certificates of Qualification issued
- 802 Interprovincial Red Seals issued
- 1679 Certificates of Qualification renewed in compulsory certified trades
  
- 1434 new apprentices registered
- 65 registered as a youth apprentice (under 20 years of age)
- Average age of new apprentices is 27.7 years
- Essential skills assessment is included as part of apprenticeship registration process
  
- Practical training provided on-the-job (85%), technical training (15%)
- 2742 apprentices received technical training
- 800 sections of in-class training offered from April 1, 2010 to March 31, 2011
- Training in most programs available in-class or via the Internet
  
- 269 applications for certification received from trade qualifiers
- 259 trade qualifier applications processed and approved
  
- 1390 examinations administered
- 1133 certification examinations written - 69% pass rate
- Apprentices wrote 677 certification examinations - 72% pass rate
- Trade qualifiers wrote 466 certification examinations - 65% pass rate
- 1069 Interprovincial examinations administered - 68% pass rate
- Apprentices wrote 641 Interprovincial examinations - 71% pass rate
- Trade qualifiers wrote 360 interprovincial examinations - 67% pass rate
- 233 progress examinations written - 73% pass rate
- Apprentices wrote 229 progress examinations with a pass rate of 72%
- Non-apprentices wrote 4 progress examinations with a pass rate of 75%
- 24 practical examinations administered -92% pass rate
